Project	Solution	
<p>The Project included a new, state of the art two storey primary school with a floodlit 3G pitch and supporting accommodation.</p> <p>The working environment was an important consideration when designing the building and large windows were utilised to provide plenty of natural light.</p> <p>To prevent glare and privacy issues, Dearnleys were asked to provide a user friendly and durable solution throughout the building.</p>	<p>Dearnleys proposed their Astralux 3000 roller blind system using a 1% screen fabric which would allow natural light to filter into the working spaces whilst reducing glare to an acceptable level and maintaining a view of the outside world for it's occupants.</p> <p>The large double height windows to the hall were fitted with heavy duty cord operated curtain tracks and a combination of black-out curtains and glare control voiles, offering the school flexibility of use in these areas.</p>
