<p>A summer house had been added to the Penthouse suite on the top floor of this apartment block.</p> <p>This afforded stunning views over Regents Park and the London skyline but solar gain and glare were problematic due to the amount and angle of the glass.</p> <p>Astralux were consulted to provide a solution to permit comfortable use of the summer house.</p>		<p>Astralux proposed their System 5000 tensioned roller blind which would allow for the vertical and sloped glazing to be covered by one blind.</p> <p>System 5000 could have conceivably covered all the glazing using just one blind but there was a client requirement to use multiple systems.</p> <p>Electrically operated this system used a fabric to reduce heat and light gain but still permit an external view.</p>
