Project	Solution	
<p>The barrel vaulted ceilings of this popular shopping centre were refurbished and the architects required an effective solution to control glare and heat gain.</p> <p>A further stipulation was that the shape of the rooflight should still be visible.</p> <p>To ensure safe working access and avoid disruption to shoppers all work had to be completed when the shopping centre was closed.</p>	<p>Astralux proposed System 5000 - a tensioned roller blind which is ideally suited to angled installations.</p> <p>The blinds are virtually imperceptible when fully retracted but offer effective glare and heat control.</p> <p>Electrical operation via radio controlled switches minimised surface mounted wiring.</p> <p>Screen fabric ensured that the shape of the roof was still visible.</p>
