| <p>The large windows at this supermarket allowed too much light to enter causing discomfort for check-out operators and customers waiting to pay for their shopping.</p> <p>A solution to reduce glare, but not exclude all light, was required.</p> <p>Due to the extended trading hours of the store work had to be scheduled to specific times when customer flow was minimal.</p> | | <p>Astralux proposed their System 3000 roller blind with a double blind in one cassette covering each window.</p> <p>To ensure effective deployment when needed the blinds were electrically operated. This had the added advantage of always ensuring the blinds lined up so that elevational consistency was maintained.</p> <p>Corona screen fabric was proposed to reduce glare but still permit an external view.</p> | |
